FOREWORD

As you go through this report, you will read the word “unprecedented” far too many times. It is factually accurate that 2024 was a year like no other for the Victorian Jewish community.

Two months stand out in a horror 2024. During May, a peaceful rally organised by Christian groups in support of the local Jewish community was infiltrated by violent counter-demonstrators. Among the horror acts, an elderly lady attending the rally was physically abused and a woman attending in a wheelchair was assaulted.

On Sunday May 25, our community woke to the news that “Jew die” had been scrawled on the wall of our largest Jewish school. Parents genuinely asked whether they could safely send their children to school on Monday.

That same month, Jewish students questioned whether they were welcome and safe at their universities, as they were forced out of public spaces and even teaching spaces by protesters screaming “all Zionists are terrorists” and calling for an “intifada revolution” a violent uprising.

Antisemitism was impacting Jewish people of all ages and backgrounds.

The second month that stands out is December. December 6 2024 will be a date remembered by the Victorian Jewish community for many years. It is the

day we woke to the news that one of our synagogues had been firebombed. This event shook the Jewish community, particularly congregants at the Adass Israel Synagogue. It will take the community many months to rebuild and regain our sense of safety, particularly as, when this report was published, no perpetrator had been arrested.

The objective of this report is to serve as a record, but also to spur action by governments, law enforcement, community organisations and individuals to ensure Jewish Victorians can live safe and proud lives.

The Jewish Community Council of Victoria (JCCV) and Community Security Group (CSG) will continue working with police command, local police, MPs and our Jewish community to address antisemitism. We also encourage and support all those who are seeking to educate against antisemitism and racism. Antisemitism is the canary in the coalmine. If we allow it to continue festering it will give license to others to discriminate and vilify other groups. This cannot happen.

This report was developed with funding support from the Victorian Government to understand and combat antisemitism in Victoria.

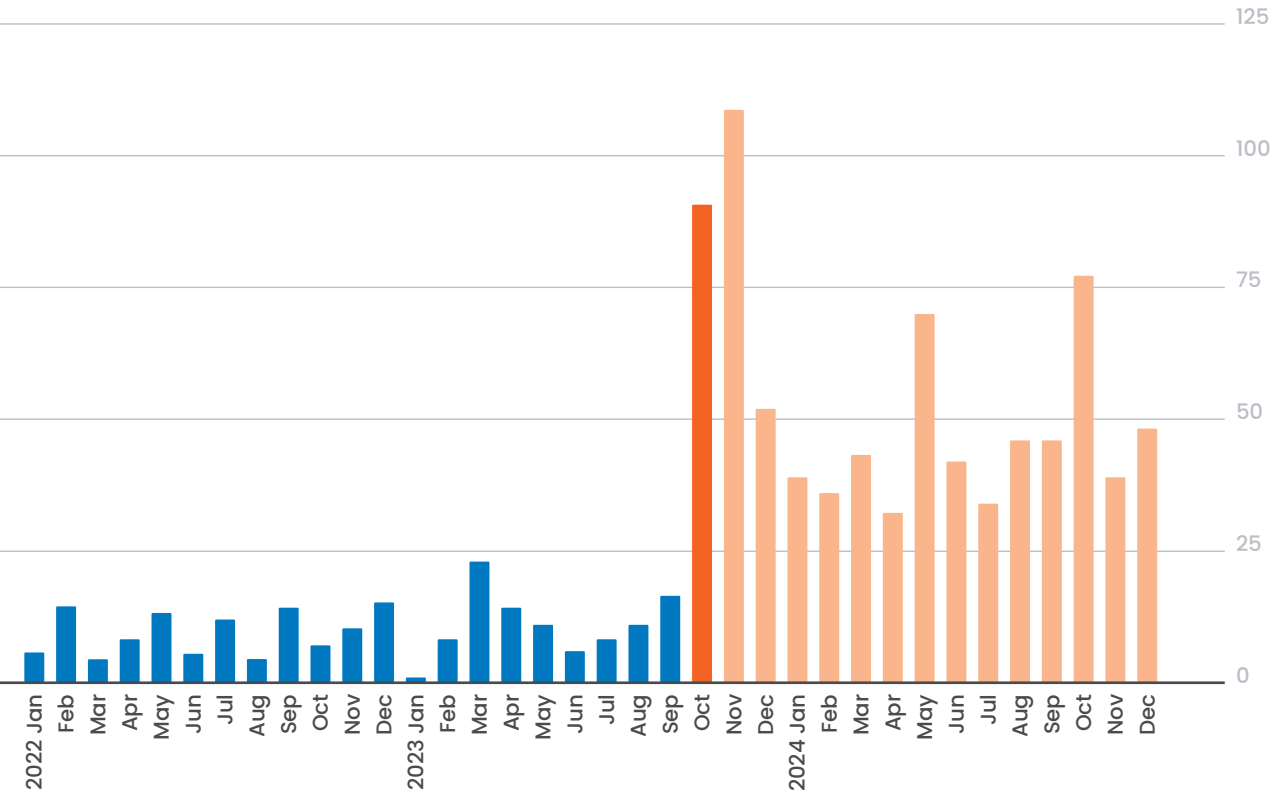

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

NUMBER OF MONTHLY INCIDENTS 2022–2024



This report collates incidents of antisemitism in Victoria in 2024 and examines emerging themes and trends. Throughout 2024, Victoria’s Jewish community continued to endure increasingly violent forms of harassment, vilification, and racism.

The 552 antisemitic incidents recorded in Victoria in 2024 is the highest total ever documented in a calendar year, and is 52% higher than the previous annual record reported in 2023.

More incidents were recorded in 2024 than during the previous five years (2018-2022). This record total reflects the sustained and elevated level of antisemitism perpetrated across Victoria since Hamas' terror attack on Israel on October 7, 2023.

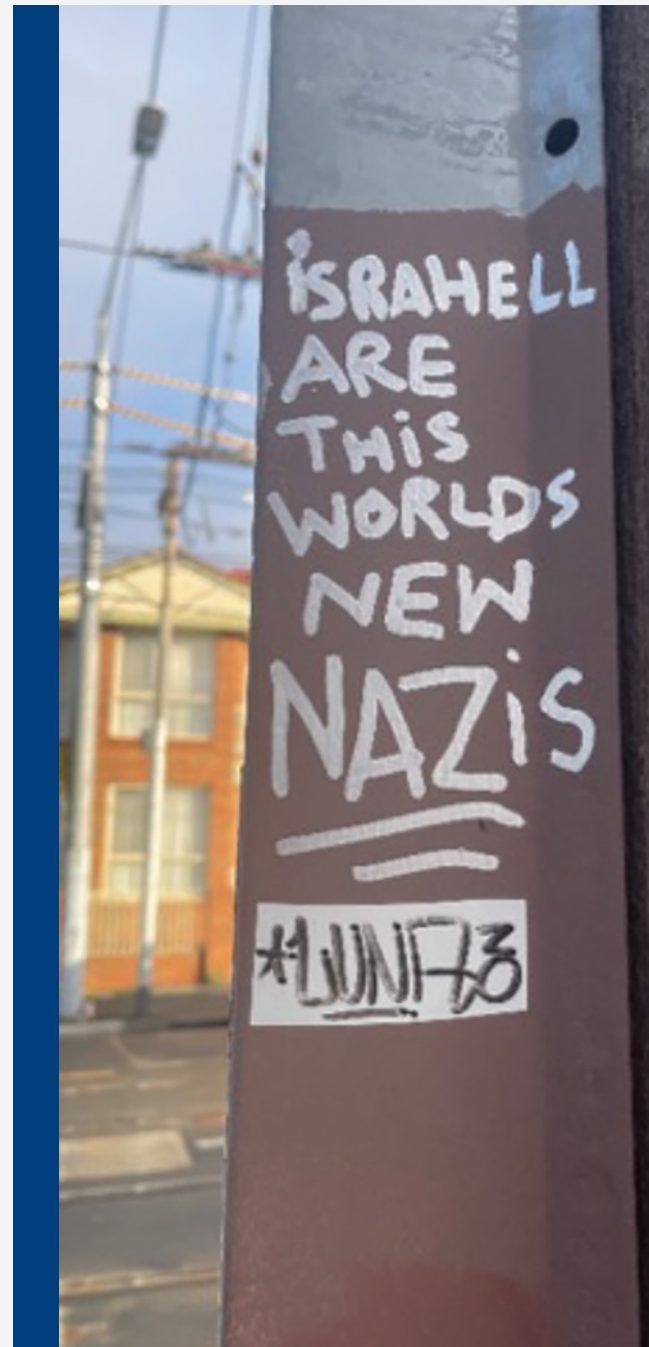
The intensification of antisemitism in 2024 reveals several key trends.

KEY TREND 1 – A high plateau

When there is an initial surge in antisemitic incidents, as was observed immediately following Hamas' October 7, 2023 attack, antisemitic incidents plateau at a higher level than prior to the trigger events. This explains why the average number of monthly incidents in 2024 was four-times higher than in 2022 and 2023 (up to October).

KEY TREND 2 – Evolving antisemitism

The unprecedented rate of incidents since October 7, 2023, highlights the evolving nature of antisemitism. It has been observed that antisemitism adapts in response to social and political contexts to provide ongoing "relevance". Whereas prior to October 7, antisemitism related to Israel-Palestine accounted for just 8% of incidents, in 2024 this had ballooned to 59% of all incidents. The 325 antisemitic incidents which explicitly referenced Israel, Zionism or Palestine in 2024 represents a 1,377% like-for-like increase on 2022, illustrating that antisemitic rhetoric has shifted since October 7, 2023. Antisemitism linked to Israel-Palestine is now the dominant form of anti-Jewish hate in Victoria. This report does not consider criticism of Israel to be antisemitic. See Appendix A for more information.



KEY TREND 3 – An ideological shift

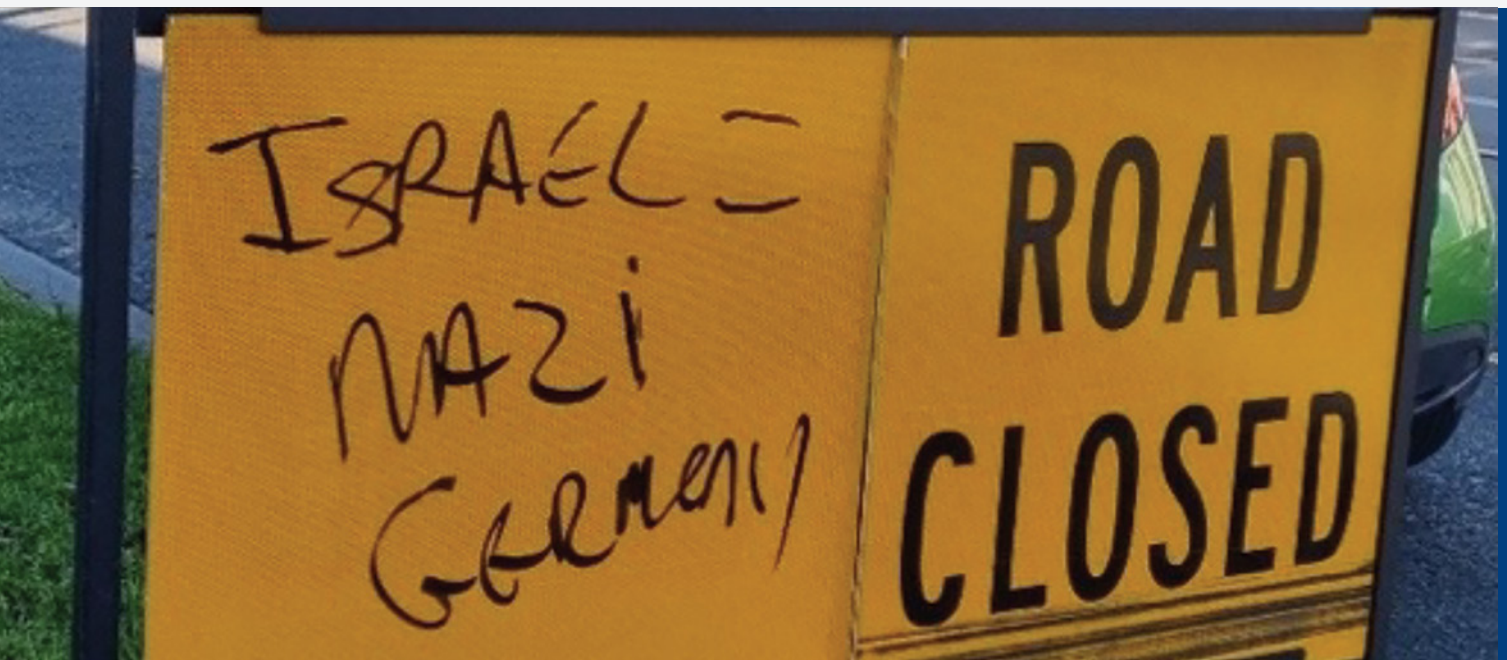
This report confirms an ideological shift in antisemitism since October 7, with antisemitism emanating from far-left political movements becoming the predominant form of anti-Jewish hate in Victoria. In 2024, 53.4% of incidents were linked to the far-left, whilst 19.7% were associated with the far-right. In contrast, prior to October 7, 59% of antisemitism was linked to the far-right, while just 8% was connected to the far-left. Importantly, although far-right antisemitism decreased as an overall percentage of incidents, far-right anti-Jewish hate was still at a record high in 2024, averaging 9.1 monthly incidents, compared to 7.1 in the first half of 2023. The changing ideological landscape of antisemitism in Victoria reflects an unprecedented escalation of far-left hatred toward Jews, rather than a decline in far-right antisemitism.

KEY TREND 4 – More dangerous, more destructive

Antisemitism is becoming more dangerous and destructive than ever before in Victoria. Violent attacks on Jewish Victorians and their property intensified since October 7, 2023. There were 42 antisemitic assaults in 2024, a 320% increase on 2023 and a 950% increase on 2022.

Of all incident types, the subcategory of assault saw the single largest year-on-year percentage increase.

In 2024, there were more than double the number of assaults than the previous five years combined. There has also been a sharp escalation in violent attacks on Jewish property. Six incidents of serious property damage were recorded, including the terrorist attack on the Adass Israel Synagogue. In comparison, there was just one incident reported in 2023, and none in 2022.



KEY TREND 5 – Break down of social cohesion

Perpetrators of antisemitism are increasingly targeting Jewish institutions in an attack on the religious and cultural fabric of Jewish life in Victoria. Jewish premises were targeted on a record 231 instances in 2024, highlighting how antisemitic actors view Jewish institutions and events as legitimate targets. These attacks on Jewish life threaten social cohesion and multiculturalism in Victoria, drain police resources and strain community tensions.

ANTI-ISRAEL INCIDENTS

In addition to the 552 antisemitic incidents recorded in 2024, a further 1,558 incidents reported to CSG contained anti-Israel rhetoric but did not meet the defined criteria for antisemitic conduct.

The unprecedented scale of these incidents – up from just one in 2022 – proves that an atmosphere of anti-Israel hatred has been normalised in Victoria. While not antisemitic, this widespread hostility towards Israel is deeply offensive and personally hurtful to many Jewish Victorians, due to their strong historical, cultural, and religious ties to Israel. As such, hostility towards Israel, even if not antisemitic per se, is perceived by many Jewish Victorians as tantamount to hostility towards Jewish people themselves. This atmosphere of anti-Israel hatred is increasingly translating into overt antisemitic attacks on ordinary Victorian Jews.



MAJOR FINDINGS

There were **552 antisemitic incidents** in Victoria in 2024, the **highest total ever** recorded in a calendar year.

In total, **58.9% of all antisemitic incidents explicitly referenced Israel, Palestine, or Zionism**, demonstrating that this has become the predominant form of anti-Jewish hate in Victoria in 2024.

Where political ideology could be identified, **53.4% of incidents were attributed to the far-left**, which occurred at a rate 27 times higher than before October 7, 2023.

19.7% of incidents were associated with far-right ideologies, while 3% were connected with Islamist ideologies.



There were an unprecedented **42 antisemitic assaults in 2024**, a 320% increase on 2023 and a 950% increase on 2022.

A record number of antisemitic incidents, **80 incidents, occurred at synagogues in 2024**. A further 92 incidents targeted Jewish cultural organisations or Jewish-owned businesses.

There were **39 incidents targeting Jewish schools and schoolchildren**, a 225% increase on the 12 incidents recorded in 2023, and a 388% increase on the 8 incidents documented in 2022.

Antisemitic incidents were reported **across 30 local government areas and 83 suburbs**, marking the widest geographic spread ever recorded in Victoria.



DEFINITION OF ANTISEMITIC INCIDENTS

Based on extensive consultation with the Victorian Jewish community as to their preferred definition of antisemitism, this report uses the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) Working Definition of Antisemitism as a guideline in defining antisemitic incidents .

“A certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities”.

In line with the IHRA definition, an **antisemitic incident** for the purposes of this report is defined as “any malicious act aimed at Jewish people, organisations or property, where there is evidence that the act has antisemitic motivation or content, or that the victim was targeted because they are (or are believed to be) Jewish”.

See Appendix A for further definition of antisemitism.

DATA COLLECTION METHODS

This report relies on data provided by CSG. CSG does not actively monitor for incidents, relying exclusively on reports made by individuals via app, website or phone call. Antisemitic incidents are reported to CSG from a wide range of sources, including from victims and their family or friends, witnesses, the CSG workforce, third-party security guards working at Jewish communal events or facilities, Jewish organisations, and law enforcement.

CSG does not collate incidents of online antisemitism. The amount of antisemitic material online is overwhelming and CSG lacks the resources to adequately monitor and track antisemitic social media posts, comments, videos, podcast, articles, memes and other content. For this reason, this report excludes general expressions of online hate against Jews, unless they are directed against specific people or institutions who report them.

Incidents of antisemitism are recorded separately by Victoria Police and the Victorian Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission. There are also antisemitic incidents that are reported to other community activists or grassroots groups. Due to the inconsistency with definitions used, difficulties in accessing some data that is reported to government or statutory entities, and difficulties ensuring single incidents are not double-counted if reported to more than one agency, the authors of this report have chosen to include CSG data only.

The authors of the report know that there is significant under-reporting of hate-based and racially vilifying incidents in Victoria. It is likely that many, and perhaps even most, antisemitic incidents are not reported to CSG. Consequently, the actual number of antisemitic incidents that occurred in Victoria in 2024 is likely to be significantly higher than that which is documented in this report. As such, the figures presented should be indicative of trends as opposed to nominal values.

ANTISEMITISM IN VICTORIA IN 2024

Victoria recorded 552 antisemitic incidents in 2024, the highest number ever documented in a single year. This is a reflection of the ongoing surge in anti-Jewish hate in Victoria, Australia and globally, since the Hamas terror attack in Israel on 7 October 2023 and the subsequent war in the region.

In Victoria, since October 2023, there have been on average 57 antisemitic incidents recorded every month.

Research has indicated that antisemitism increases in Australia during times of conflict in Israel. However, the scale and nature of antisemitism perpetrated in Victoria throughout 2024 has been exponentially greater than that witnessed in previous conflicts involving Israel. For example, during the previous conflict in May 2021, the highest monthly tally was 18 incidents.

One contributing factor is the prolonged duration of the Gaza war and the related conflict in Lebanon, resulting in sustained media attention and public scrutiny. However, the intensity and unprecedented scale of antisemitism when compared to previous conflicts involving Israel makes clear that this is a new and distinct form of antisemitism.

Beyond its intensified scale, what makes post-October 7 antisemitism unique is its overarching connection to the Israel-Palestine conflict, and its more violent and physical manifestations.

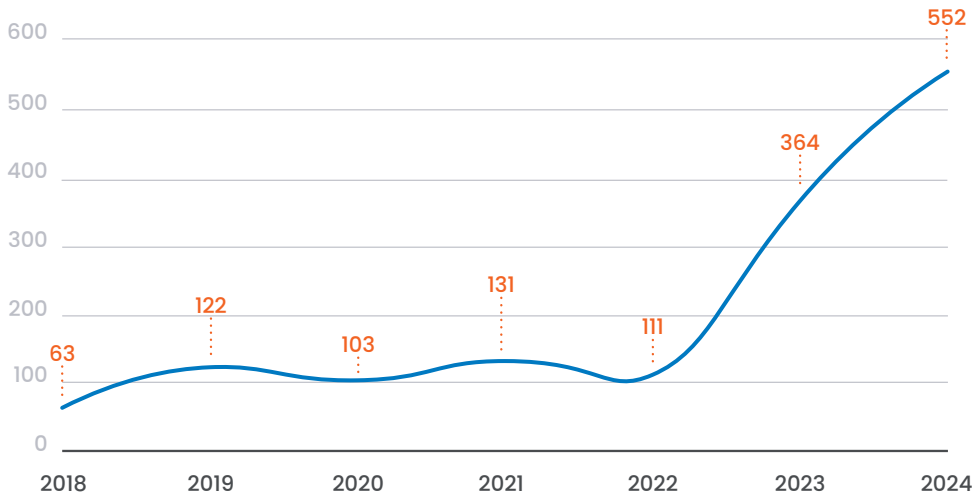


COMPARING ANTISEMITISM IN 2024 TO PREVIOUS YEARS

In 2024, antisemitic incidents occurred at a rate 52% higher than the 2023 annual record and more than quadruple the pre-October 7 record set in 2021.

More incidents were recorded in 2024 than the five years of 2018–2022 combined.

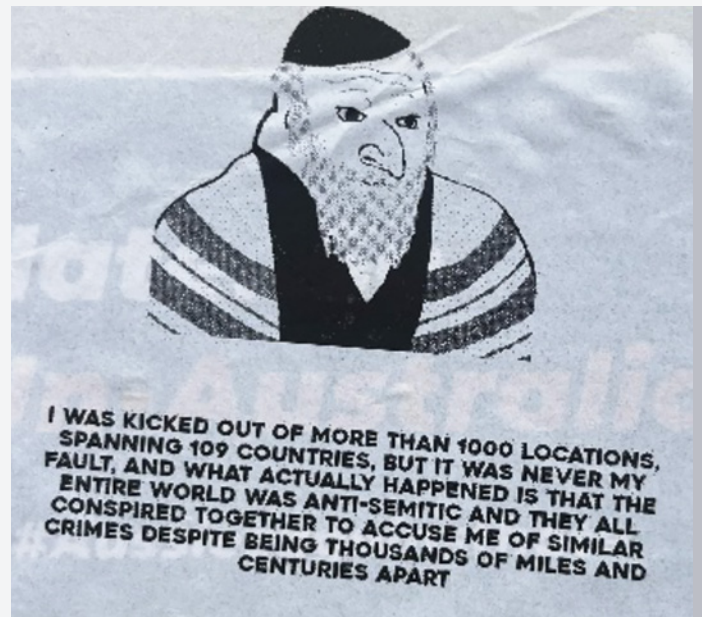
ANNUAL INCIDENTS 2018–2024



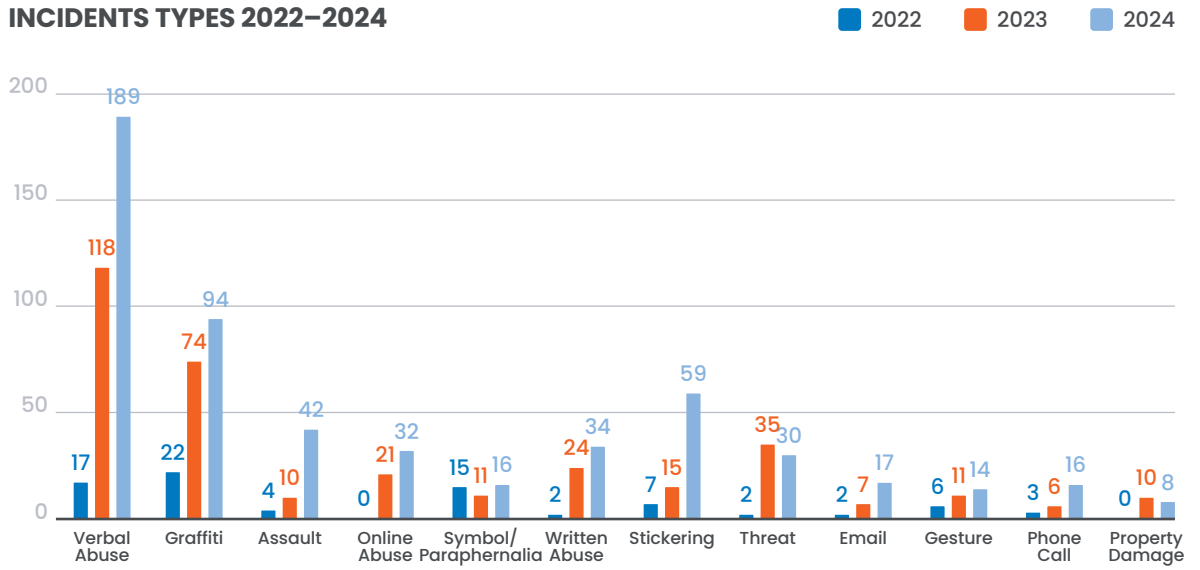
All categories of antisemitic conduct occurred at a significantly higher rate in 2024 compared to pre-October 7 levels. Consistent with 2023, the two largest categories of incidents were verbal abuse, with 189 incidents, and graffiti, with 94. Verbal abuse was 1,012% higher than pre-October 7, while graffiti was 327% more frequent. There was a notable increase in antisemitic stickering, up 743% since 2022.

The subcategory with the single largest annual percentage increase was assaults, up 320% year on year and 950% since 2022.

Antisemitic threats declined year on year. This suggests that perpetrators of antisemitism have escalated their threats of violence into physical acts of hate.



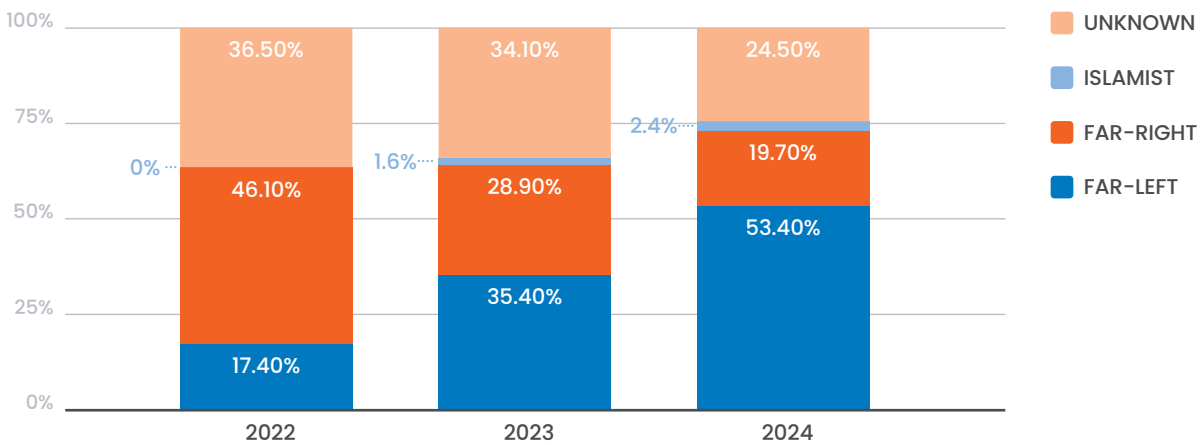
INCIDENTS TYPES 2022–2024



Continuing a trend observed since October 7, antisemitism linked to a far-left political ideology grew as an overall proportion of incidents in 2024, while far-right incidents declined as a percentage compared to previous years.

Additionally, there was an increase in antisemitic incidents linked to Islamist ideology. The distinct ideological composition of antisemitism in 2024 reflects the rapid escalation of far-left antisemitism perpetrated since October 7, as opposed to a decline in far-right antisemitism.

ANTISEMITIC DISCOURSES AND IDEOLOGIES IN 2024

ISRAEL-PALESTINE RELATED ANTISEMITISM

Throughout 2024, the discourse most often reported in antisemitic incidents involved references to Israel, Palestine, or Zionism. It is essential to reiterate that this report explicitly distinguishes between legitimate criticisms of the Israeli Government, Israeli military and Israeli policies or actions, and antisemitism – as defined by the IHRA definition of antisemitism. As explained earlier in the report, 1558 reports to CSG were excluded from this report because while they were anti-Israel, they were not deemed antisemitic.

However 325 antisemitic incidents linked to Israel – 59% of all incidents recorded in 2024 – have been counted. Israel-inspired antisemitism has become the predominant form of anti-Jewish hate in Victoria.



The shift towards antisemitism containing Israel-Palestine rhetoric demonstrates the changing nature of antisemitism, which while a deeply embedded hatred, adapts in response to the given social and political context to give it newfound “relevance”.



This evolution in antisemitic rhetoric is demonstrated by the 1,368% like-for-like increase in Israel-related incidents in 2024 compared to 2022. Importantly, antisemitism has not simply shifted towards Israel-Palestine rhetoric. Instead, Israel-related antisemitism has surged exponentially, fundamentally reshaping the landscape of anti-Jewish hate and driving it to levels unprecedented in Victoria’s history.

The 462 Israel-related antisemitic incidents documented between October 7, 2023, and 31 December, 2024 is more than quadruple the total number of antisemitic incidents recorded in all of 2022.

THEMES IN ISRAEL-PALESTINE INCIDENTS

Discourse relating to Israel-Palestine is used by antisemitic offenders to torment and abuse Jews. Local Jewish people or Jewish faith-based or cultural-based organisations have also been used as a “proxy” or stand in for those who seek to express a negative opinion towards Israel. The most common form of Israel-related antisemitism intertwined hostility toward Israel with overt hatred for Jews, as reflected in phrases such as “free Palestine, you f***** Jewish c***” and “all Jews are racist genocide supporters”. 240 incidents of this nature were recorded.



A further 70 Israel-related incidents equated Jews or Israel to the Nazis, or accused Jews of committing a Holocaust. This deeply hurtful, abusive and completely false charge deliberately weaponises the genocide of six million Jews and the trauma it represents, whilst also trivialising the horrors of the Holocaust.

In 2024, anti-Israel discourse also repeated, or echoed, longstanding antisemitic imagery and tropes. For example, 13 incidents combined the centuries-old myth of the Blood Libel with a loathing for Israel, accusing ordinary Victorian Jews of mutilating and murdering children in Gaza. These included harassing statements such as "you are killing all the children in Palestine, you're responsible".

FAR-LEFT ANTISEMITISM

The predominant source of antisemitism in 2024 was the political far-left, defined in this report as those coming from revolutionary socialist, anarchist or radical anti-fascist ideologies. This type of antisemitism collectively accounted for a majority (53.4%) of all incidents documented, and 71.1% of incidents where a motivating ideology could be identified.

The 295 incidents of antisemitism attributed to the far-left in 2024 is more than double the annual pre-October 7 record set in 2021. Prior to October 7, far-left antisemitism was identified in just 8% of all incidents. Between January and September 2023, far-left antisemitism was perpetrated at a rate of one incident per month. However, in 2024, this had surged to 27 incidents per month.

The rapid increase in far-left motivated antisemitism was the driving force behind the unprecedented level of antisemitism perpetrated in Victoria throughout 2024.

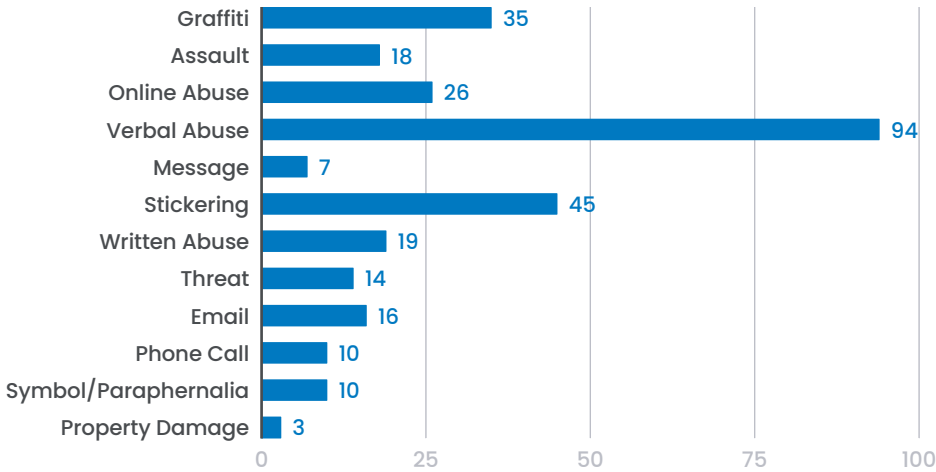
The discourse surrounding far-left antisemitism was almost unanimously consistent.

99% of far-left motivated antisemitism was explicitly connected to Israel, Palestine, or Zionism. 20 incidents of far-left antisemitism also expressed support for terrorist organisations.

For antisemitic assaults where ideology could be identified, all were connected to the far-left, suggesting this was the most violent form of antisemitism in 2024.

FAR-RIGHT ANTISEMITISM

While far-right motivated antisemitism decreased as an overall percentage of incidents compared to pre-October 7 levels, these incidents were still perpetrated at a record rate across Victoria in 2024. 109 cases of far-right antisemitism were documented in 2024, representing 19.7% of the annual total. By contrast, between 1 January and October 6 2023, far-right motivations were identified in 59% of incidents.

Despite a sharp decline as an overall proportion of incidents, far-right antisemitism nonetheless occurred at a record rate in 2024.

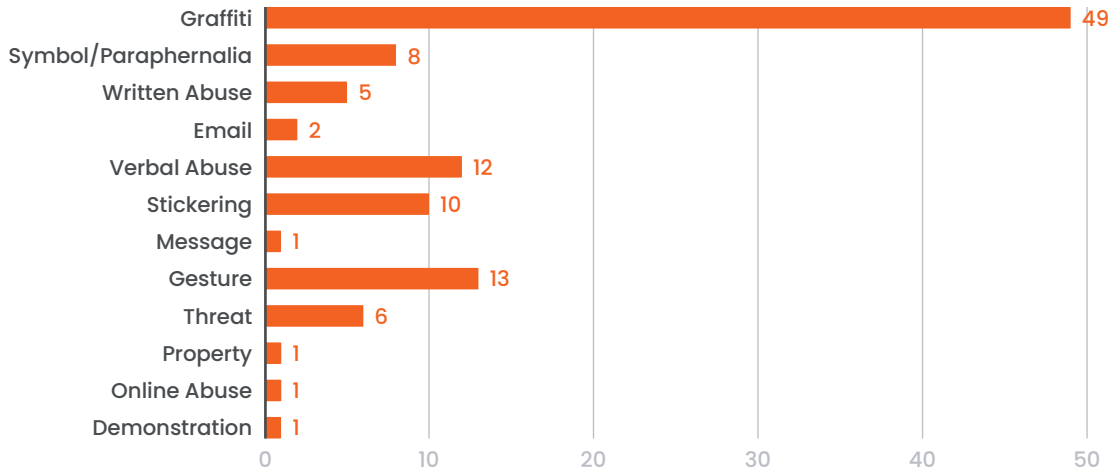
The 109 far-right motivated incidents in 2024 is effectively equivalent to the total annual incident count for 2022 (111). The intensified frequency of far-right antisemitism was a contributing factor to the record levels of antisemitism perpetrated in Victoria in 2024.

THEMES IN FAR-RIGHT INCIDENTS

There was a notable shift in far-right rhetoric in 2024. The most common discourse in far-right incidents involved references to Hitler, Nazis or white supremacy, which was evident in 78 cases. In previous years, virtually all far-right incidents expressed this type of rhetoric. However, in 2024 far-right incidents referenced Israel-Palestine in 28.4% of cases. These included, for instance, the verbal abuse "heil Hitler, f*** your Jewish state".



FAR-RIGHT INCIDENT CATEGORIES (2024)



The significant proportion of far-right incidents related to Israel-Palestine marks an emerging phenomenon, suggesting an alignment between far-right and far-left actors in their shared hostility toward Jews associated with Israel.

The most common far-right incident category was graffiti, which accounted for 45% of all far-right antisemitism.

ISLAMIST ANTISEMITISM

The remaining ideology identified in incidents was Islamism, which was linked to 2.4% of cases. An example of an incident in this category was a threat made to a Jewish museum saying, “go to hell. Free Palestine. Death to all that kill innocent little Palestinian children. We are coming for you, your children and your whore of wife’s.”

The 13 incidents in this category included threats (3), verbal (3) and written (2) abuse, graffiti (3) and stickers (2). 63.6% of Islamist incidents also expressed support for terrorist organisations. Such incidents included, for example, the threat “fucking Jew, I support Hamas, you don’t want to mess with me”.

ADASS ISRAEL SYNAGOGUE FIREBOMBING



INCIDENT

At approximately 4:10am on Friday December 6, an arson attack occurred at the Adass Israel Synagogue in Ripponlea, Melbourne. Two masked perpetrators entered the synagogue, doused it with an accelerant which they spread with a broom, and set it on fire. The synagogue quickly caught ablaze, causing substantial damage to its interior and partly collapsing the roof. One congregant was injured in the incident. The damage to the synagogue is estimated to be many millions of dollars. On 9 December 2024, Victoria Police officially designated the incident as a terrorist attack

IMPACT

The firebombing of the synagogue caused profound distress and fear for both the congregants at the Adass Israel Synagogue, but also Victoria's Jewish community, shattering the sense of security that many Jewish Victorians once felt.

The attack has left the Adass Israel community, one of the most active Jewish communities in Victoria, without a permanent synagogue. Benjamin Klein, a board member of the Adass Israel synagogue, described how the synagogue was the "central point of the community." It is anticipated that a full rebuild will take up to two years. In the meantime, the community has relocated to multiple sites, none of which are large enough to welcome all congregants at once. This has left the community's women and children, in particular, without a community centre or place of worship.

For the broader Jewish community, images of the Adass Israel synagogue on fire have stirred painful memories of atrocities committed against Jews in the past, leading some to question their safety in Victoria.

PERPETRATORS

A Joint Counter-Terrorism Team, made up of the Australian Federal Police, Victoria Police and ASIO, was assigned to coordinate the investigation into the Adass Israel synagogue attack.

Media reports said police were investigating three suspects but as of early 2025, no arrests had been made and no one had claimed responsibility.

REACTION

The attack was met with widespread condemnation from all levels of government and the community.

"The firebombing of the Adass Israel Synagogue was a vile act of cruelty against a tight-knit community.

It was crime of cowardice and prejudice. Above all it was an act of terrorism. I join with other Australians my total and unequivocal condemnation of this crime and everything it represents. This was a fire fuelled by antisemitism and stoked by hatred."

The firebombing also received global attention. For the first time ever, the US-based Simon Wiesenthal Center issued a travel warning for Jews visiting Australia, advising them to exercise "extreme caution" as it was "not convinced that Jews are safe [in Australia]".



THE ALARMING SURGE IN VIOLENCE AGAINST JEWISH VICTORIANS

Noted in 2024 was the surge in physical and violent attacks against Jewish Victorians and their property. Such incidents comprised 50 cases, representing 9% of all incidents in 2024. The vast majority of these attacks involved physical assaults on Jewish people.

ANTISEMITIC ASSAULTS

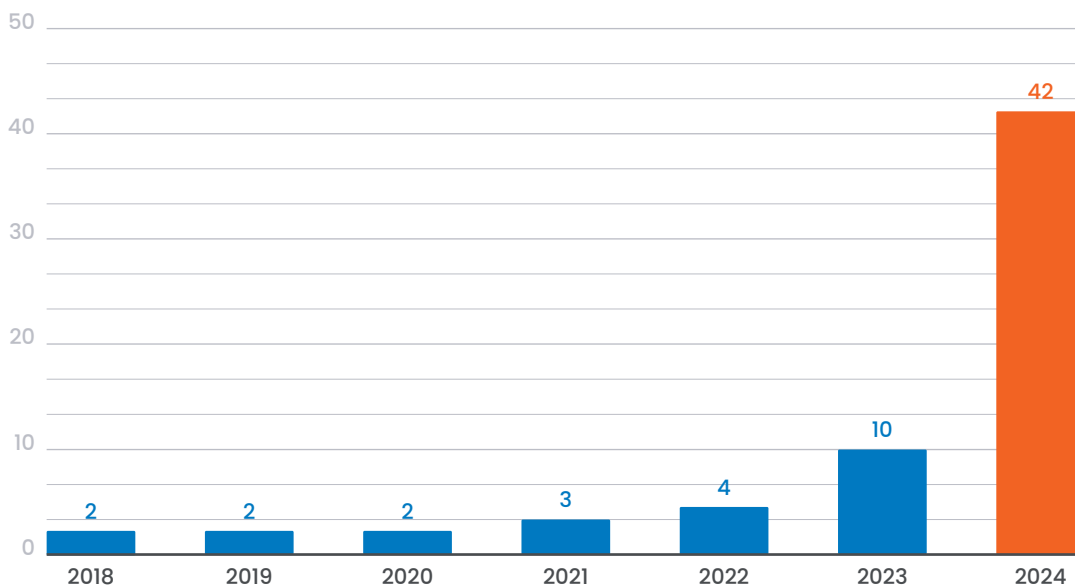
42 antisemitic assaults were documented in 2024 – a figure double the previous five years combined.

This represents an acceleration of the trend toward violent attacks on Jews following October 7, 2023. Of all incident types, the subcategory of assault saw the single largest year-on-year percentage increase (320%).

7.6% of all antisemitic incidents in 2024 were physical assaults, compared to 2.9% in 2023, underscoring a shift from non-physical to more violent and aggressive attacks on Jews. The number of threats as a proportion of all incidents almost halved from 10.2% in 2023 to 5.4% in 2024. One explanation could be that perpetrators of antisemitism have escalated their threats into physical acts of violence.

Ideological or political motivations were identified in 18 of the 42 assaults. In each of these cases, the assaults expressed far-left political views. This suggests that far-left antisemitism was the most violent form of anti-Jewish hate in Victoria in 2024.

YEARLY ANTISEMITIC ASSAULTS IN VICTORIA (2018–2024)



ASSAULT IN CBD

On Spencer Street in Melbourne, two Jewish individuals were approached by approximately 15 individuals, having been identified as Jewish because they were wearing Star of David necklaces. They were verbally abused including with phrases such as "baby rapers", "You Jews are now the Nazis", "It's a shame that Hitler didn't finish the job", "Free Palestine", "Genocide supporters", "F***** Zionists" and "kikes". The two Jews were then pushed against a wall and repeatedly elbowed and punched in the head. One victim was admitted to hospital for medical treatment.



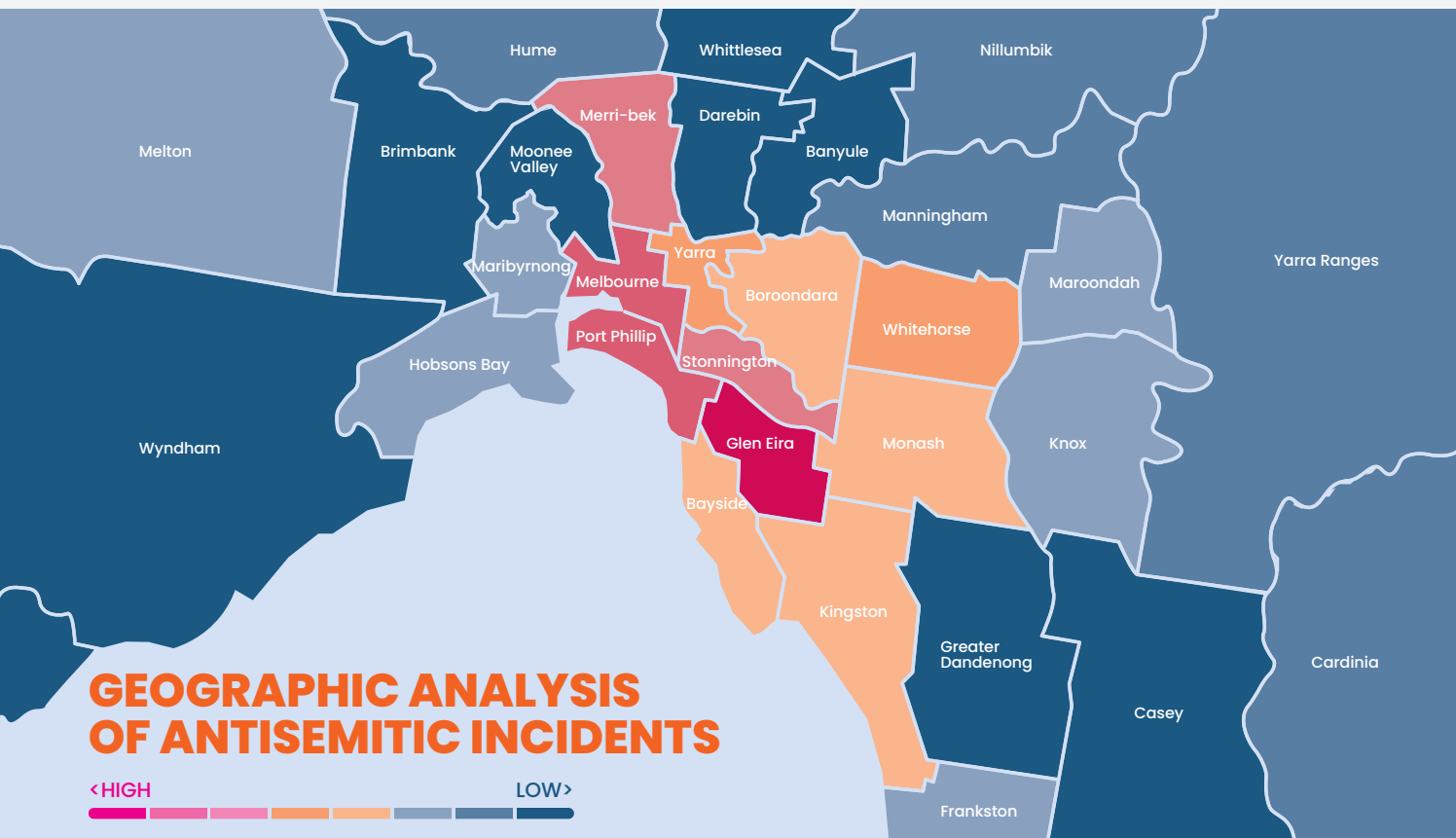
DAMAGE AND DESECRATION OF JEWISH PROPERTY

Six incidents of serious property destruction, defined as extensive damage requiring repair, were recorded, marking a 500% increase from the single incident reported in 2023. No such incidents were documented in 2022.

These attacks included the firebombing of the Adass Israel Synagogue, multiple instances

of window-smashing at other synagogues, vandalism and damage to the office of Member for Macnamara Josh Burns, a Jewish man, and the shattering of an identifiable community member's car windows. This surge in property destruction underscores a broader trend of escalating violence targeting Victoria's Jewish community.





The unprecedented scale of antisemitism in Victoria in 2024 was reflected in the broad geographic spread of incidents.

Antisemitism was recorded across 30 local government areas and 83 suburbs, marking the widest geographic spread ever documented in Victoria.

ANTISEMITISM IN MELBOURNE’S INNER SOUTH-EASTERN SUBURBS

Consistent with previous years, antisemitic incidents centred around the areas with the largest Jewish communities. The City of Glen Eira, the area with the largest Jewish population in Australia according to the 2021 Census, recorded 226 incidents, accounting for 41% of all in-person antisemitism reported in 2024. The suburbs of St Kilda East, Caulfield North, Caulfield, and Elsternwick collectively accounted for 171 incidents, constituting 31% of all incidents reported. These suburbs are home to many Jewish Victorians.

An additional 86 incidents (15.6%) occurred in the City of Port Phillip, while 31 incidents (5.6%) were reported in the City of Stonnington, each of which have sizable Jewish communities.



ANTISEMITISM IN THE CITY OF MELBOURNE

88 antisemitic incidents were reported in the City of Melbourne in 2024, compared to 33 in 2023 (5 prior to October 7), and just 4 incidents in 2022. The 2,100% increase in antisemitism perpetrated in the City of Melbourne compared to 2022 is largely due to various pro-Palestinian demonstrations that have taken place in the CBD weekly since October 7, 2023. While mostly peaceful, these protests have also been attended by individuals who displayed anti-Jewish placards, engaged in hate speech, and committed verbal and physical assaults. The Australian Federal Police charged two men with displaying prohibited terrorist symbols at a rally in Melbourne’s CBD on September 29, in this case the flags of the Lebanese terrorist group Hizballah, which seeks Israel’s destruction. The AFP was investigating 14 people for similar offences so more charges may result.

ANTISEMITISM IN MELBOURNE’S INNER SUBURBS

Despite its smaller Jewish populations, Melbourne’s inner-north observed a large increase in antisemitic incidents in 2024. The cities of Merri-Bek, Yarra and Boroondara accounted for 35 incidents, compared to just 15 in 2023 and 6 in 2022.

ANTISEMITISM IN RURAL VICTORIA

Seven antisemitic incidents were reported in rural Victoria. Three incidents in rural Victoria expressed far right ideology, two anti-Israel/pro-Palestine rhetoric, while two could not be classified.

It should be noted that the nature of data collection by CSG means that incident reports are skewed towards areas where Jewish people live or frequent. It is possible that antisemitism is higher across Victoria but that people who witness or experience it in those areas are unfamiliar with CSG and do not report it.

NEVER AGAIN IS NOW RALLY

On the day of the only CBD-based demonstration held in support of the Jewish community, Victoria recorded the most daily antisemitic incidents ever documented in its history.

On Sunday May 19, 2024, the "Never Again is Now" rally took place at Victoria's Parliament House.

Organised by a Christian grassroots movement, the rally was intended to condemn antisemitism and express support for the local Jewish community. The event featured a range of speakers, including politicians, Indigenous leaders, and religious representatives from diverse communities. Around 3,000 people attended the peaceful rally.

The Never Again is Now rally was the only large-scale city-based demonstration in support of the Jewish community in 2024. The event coincided with the weekly pro-Palestinian demonstration, which was attended by around 4,000 people. Despite police working with rally organisers to find separate locations and re-routing the pro-Palestinian march away from the Never Again is Now rally, several hundred counter-demonstrators gathered near the Never Again is Now rally. Victoria Police were required to form lines separating the counter protestors.

Despite the strong police presence, 15 antisemitic incidents were reported to CSG, with police making six arrests. As attendees made their way to and from the rally, eight antisemitic assaults were recorded, double the total number of assaults documented in all of 2022. Event organisers Never Again is Now reportedly received 56 complaints of antisemitic incidents.

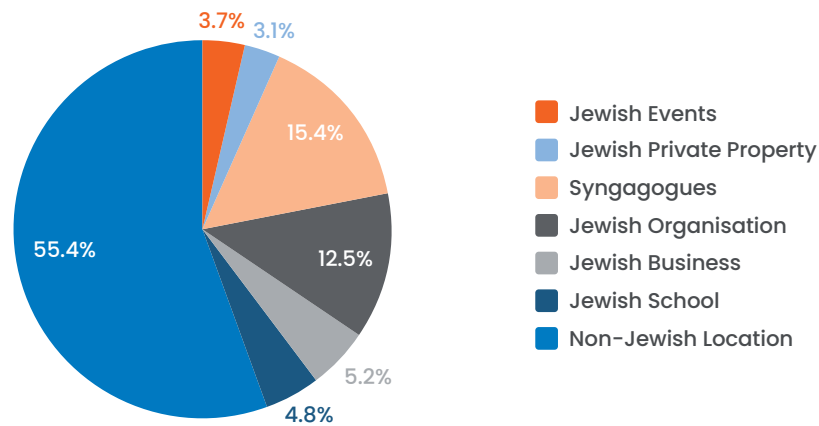
ANTISEMITISM ON OPEN DISPLAY

Dozens of Jewish attendees, including children, were called "Nazis", "child rapists", "Jewish pigs", "kid killers" and "kippah wearing faggots" by counter-protestors. Others were accused of personally "committing a holocaust" and "murdering babies" as they walked through the police corridor to attend the rally. Attendees were also told that "another Holocaust" was coming for Jews. This torrent of verbal abuse caused profound fear, trauma and distress for Jewish attendees.

Jewish attendees, including children and elderly, were also physically assaulted despite a heavy police presence. In one instance, an identifiable Jew was surrounded by 10 counter protestors and kicked hard in the legs and arms several times, sustaining significant bruising. In another instance, an elderly lady was physically attacked, and needed to be treated in a nearby ambulance. A child with cerebral palsy had an Israeli flag stolen off her wheelchair. Others reported being pushed to the ground, punched in the face, struck by umbrellas and spat upon.

ATTACKS ON JEWISH LIFE: ANTISEMITISM AND WEAKENING SOCIAL COHESION

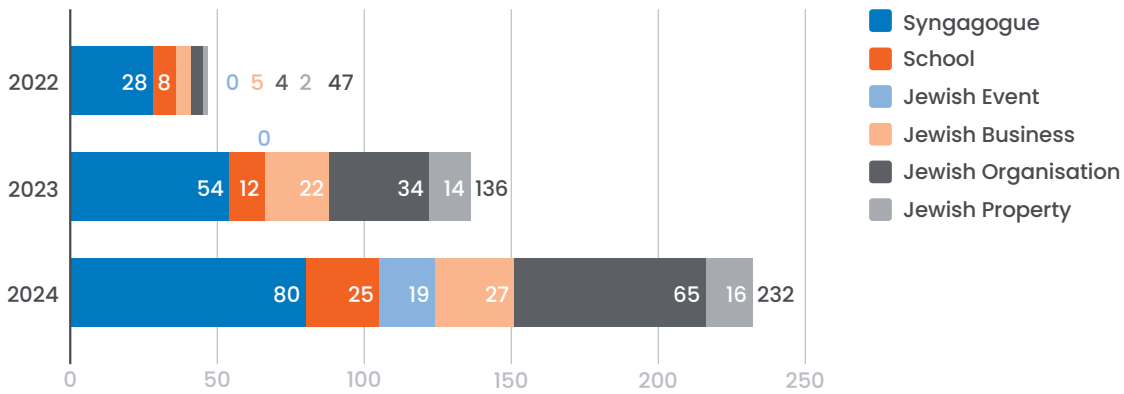
Throughout 2024, antisemitic actors increasingly targeted religious and cultural institutions in an attack on Jewish life in Victoria. 232 antisemitic incidents were recorded at Jewish locations, organisations and events, representing 44.7% of all in-person incidents in 2024. The number of antisemitic incidents recorded at Jewish premises in 2024 was more than double the total number of incidents recorded in all of 2022.

The increased targeting of Jewish venues and synagogues has obstructed the free practice of religion and undermined social cohesion in Victoria.

For instance, at a panel event organised by two Jewish organisations at a prominent Melbourne synagogue, approximately a dozen pro-Palestinian rallied outside to protest against “genocide”. These protestors were met by hundreds of Jewish community counter protestors, who separated by police, chanted at each other. Two pro-Palestinian protestors were arrested by police.

The confrontation outside the synagogue demonstrates the growing threat of hostile actors disrupting Jewish events and creating an atmosphere of intimidation and fear. This targeting of Jewish institutions, particularly synagogues, constitutes a direct attack on multiculturalism in Victoria.

The targeting of Jewish venues has also amplified community concerns about the safety of attending Jewish functions. This increased concern can be demonstrated by the 50% increase in community events registered with CSG in 2024 compared to 2023.

Due to the heightened risk of antisemitic targeting, Jewish functions increasingly require paid security guards. The cost of security must either be absorbed by organisers or passed onto attendees, increasing the cost of grassroots events.

When advertising events, Jewish organisations no longer publicise locations for fear of hostile attendees, and RSVP lists are carefully vetted in advance of attendance. The increased complexity and costs of running Jewish community events in Victoria is a reflection of the unprecedented hostility, vilification and hatred endured by the Jewish community. By making Jewish life more difficult, the targeting of Jewish locations amounts to a broader attack on social cohesion and multiculturalism in Victoria, straining community tensions and draining police resources.





JEWISH CHILDREN AND SCHOOLS TARGETED

In 2024, there was a significant escalation in antisemitic incidents targeting Jewish schoolchildren and Jewish schools.

There were 39 reports of antisemitism against Jewish schoolchildren and Jewish schools. This is a 225% rise from 2023, when 12 incidents were reported.

Antisemitic incidents targeting Jewish schoolchildren were motivated by ideologies across the political spectrum. 50% of incidents explicitly referenced Israel, Palestine or Zionism and were classified as far-left, while 25% expressed far-right or neo-Nazi themes. The remaining 25% could not be linked to a specific discourse or ideology.

ANTISEMITIC ATTACKS ON JEWISH CHILDREN

- On August 14, a group of identifiably Jewish schoolgirls were verbally abused and threatened on a tram. A woman shouted at them, "I can't believe how ridiculous and stupid it is that you go to a school that teaches you lies that Israel exists. Palestine exists not Israel. I support Palestine and I will not stand here while you fucking cunts are wearing a uniform of a Jewish school. You are committing genocide. I don't fucking care how old you are I will come and find you and cut off your head."
- On September 1, two identifiably Jewish school students were walking through the underpass at Caulfield train station when a group of 8 to 10 teenage males called them "fucking Jews".



Despite efforts to ignore the comments, the males approached the students demanding “what school do you go to”. One male then proceeded to punch a Jewish student in the face, who was subsequently taken to hospital in a moderate condition.

- On October 7, two young identifiably Jewish students were walking home from school when a male in a passing vehicle yelled at them “I am going to kill you”.

EXAMPLES OF ANTISEMITIC INCIDENTS TARGETING JEWISH SCHOOLS

- On May 25, an individual graffitied the words “JEW DIE” in black spray paint on the wall of the main entrance to Mount Scopus Memorial College, Australia’s largest Jewish school.

- On November 27, the occupant of a passing vehicle threw an explosive firework in the direction of the main entrance of a Jewish primary school. The object exploded at the school gate, producing a loud bang and smoke.
- On February 2, the Australian Council of Jewish Schools received hate mail, which read “ISRAEL IS EVIL JEWS ARE EVIL YOU ARE AS EVIL AS THE NAZIS. WHY CAN’T YOU SEE THAT?”

CASE STUDY 3

ANTISEMITISM ON VICTORIAN UNIVERSITY CAMPUSES

Concerns over antisemitism on Victorian university campuses have been longstanding and persistent. A nationwide survey of Australian university students, released in August 2023, found that 64% of Jewish students experienced antisemitism on campus, and that a majority (57%) of students hid their Jewish identity at university.

However, antisemitism reached new heights at local universities in 2024.

Throughout 2024, Jewish university students faced extreme hostility, vilification and discrimination, as universities became a focal point for pro-Palestinian activism including disruptive encampments.

Despite there only being a few hundred Jewish university students across the state, 21 incidents of antisemitism were reported on Victorian campuses in 2024, a record figure. Two thirds of these incidents occurred in the month of May, when pro-Palestinian encampments were established across several Victorian universities. These encampments, including the occupation of a building at the University of Melbourne, served as a catalyst for increased antisemitic behaviour on campus.

Extreme hostility directed towards Israel was the predominant form of antisemitism on campus, evident in 90% of incidents and two incidents expressed support for terror organisations. An additional 131 incidents were reported to CSG that contained anti-Israel rhetoric but were not classified as antisemitic, underscoring the widespread atmosphere of anti-Israel hatred that existed on campus.

It should be noted that it is likely that antisemitism at Victorian universities was far more widespread than reported to CSG. The Parliamentary Inquiry into Antisemitism at Australian Universities received hundreds of submissions from Jewish students saying they felt unsafe during weeks-long pro-Palestine encampments. The Special Envoy to Combat Antisemitism, Jillian Segal, stated that antisemitism is embedded in university culture. This underreporting of incidents is in large part due to the feeling that reporting antisemitism would not lead to any significant action or punishment of offenders. Indeed, the Senate committee into antisemitism on campus found that university responses were “woefully inadequate” and that “brazen antisemitism” had gone unchecked by universities.



RESPONSES TO ANTISEMITISM ON CAMPUS

- A survey conducted by the Australian Academic Alliance Against Antisemitism from April to July 2024 found only one third of Jewish students surveyed felt a sense of safety on campus .
- An impact report completed by CSG in May 2024 found the atmosphere towards “Zionists” at universities was extremely hostile and impacted negatively on Jewish students, most of whom identify as Zionist.
- The Senate Standing Committee on Legal and Constitutional Affairs completed an inquiry into the Commission of Inquiry into Antisemitism at Australian Universities Bill 2024 and recommended that all Australian universities review the way they have handled antisemitism.
- The Parliamentary Joint Committee on Human Rights completed an inquiry antisemitism at Australian universities, finding a “disturbing prevalence of antisemitism that has left Jewish students and staff feeling unsafe, hiding their identity on campus and even avoiding campus all together”. The committee made 10 recommendations.

FROM THE AUSTRALASIAN UNION OF JEWISH STUDENTS

“Jewish students have reported feeling unsafe, ostracised, and targeted for their identity. The pervasive nature of these incidents, including verbal abuse, hostile rhetoric, physical threats, and discriminatory actions, has led to a significant decline in their sense of belonging and safety on campus. Many students have expressed a loss of motivation to attend classes, participate in university activities or even openly express their Jewish identity. The constant exposure to antisemitism both on campus and in the wider world has created an environment where Jewish students feel marginalised and fearful.”



APPENDIX A

DEFINING ANTISEMITIC INCIDENTS

ANTISEMITIC INCIDENTS

An incident is categorised as **antisemitic** if it fulfills at least one of the following criteria:

- Expresses **anti-Jewish hate** (e.g., "F**king Jew"), including using anti-Jewish tropes (e.g., hooked nose);
- Expresses intimidation towards an individual **based on that individual's perceived association with Judaism**;
- Expresses support for a **radical ideology or an extremist view of religion which targets Jewish people** (e.g., Nazi symbology, Hamas Flag);
- **Expresses representations of Israel, Zionism, or Israelis with the Holocaust or Nazism** (i.e., invoking Jewish trauma to target Israel or Zionism); or
- **Directs anti-Israel hate towards an identifiably Jewish individual or location**, whereby the individual or location does not display any connection to Israel (i.e., targeted solely because they are Jewish).
